

NDS WINS CONTRACT TO PROVIDE CONDITIONAL ACCESS SECURITY ON VIASAT PAY TV PLATFORM

Highlights:

- NDS provides VideoGuard® secure conditional access for MTG's Viasat direct to home (DTH) satellite pay-TV platform
- NDS VideoGuard to protect content delivered to over 600,000 digital subscribers
- Positive addition to NDS's conditional access customer portfolio

London, UK – March 31, 2003: NDS Group plc, a News Corporation company and the leading provider of technology solutions for digital pay-TV, today announced that a contract has been signed with Viasat Broadcasting, the pay and free TV satellite broadcasting division of leading Northern European media group Modern Times Group MTG AB, to deploy NDS VideoGuard® conditional access (CA) on Viasat's digital pay-TV platform in the Nordic region.

VideoGuard conditional access will be deployed by Viasat Broadcasting on its DTH pay-TV platform in Sweden, Norway, Denmark and Finland to protect Viasat's digital subscribers from piracy and to reduce churn on the platform.

NDS's VideoGuard will initially work in parallel to the existing system using a Simulcrypt headend. This is essential to avoid disruption to the service and in order to start creating a more secure platform. The full rollout will include a total migration of existing digital subscriber set-top boxes to NDS's CA via an over-the-air download.

Viasat chose CA from NDS to help resolve a significant piracy issue. In addition, it will allow Viasat to take advantage of new services offered by NDS's conditional access solution, including revenue-generating opportunities leading to increased ARPU for Viasat's pay-TV business.

Dr Abe Peled, President and CEO, NDS Group plc, said: "We are delighted to be selected by Viasat to help secure their business and provide added value. We see Viasat as an important new customer for NDS, one that will be a major player in Scandinavia and Eastern Europe. NDS's broad technology base coupled with our ongoing investments will help support the pay-TV business expansion and the future growth of Viasat".

Hans-Holger Albrecht, President and CEO of MTG, commented: "We chose NDS because it is the most secure system available. MTG and NDS share a combined objective to eliminate piracy and we expect this implementation to substantially reduce subscriber churn levels and accelerate Viasat's digital subscriber acquisition".

NDS's VideoGuard is currently used by over 31 million subscribers around the world and secures over \$11 billion of customer revenues.
